Dear Friends

It's amazing to think that other than some sketchy stories of Jesus' birth and childhood most of what we are told in the Bible about his life takes place over just a very few short years.

They are years crammed full of activity. Travelling from village to village spending much time preaching and teaching, in Synagogues, on hills and beside lakes, and in people's homes.

We know nothing about what Jesus did before beginning his ministry, perhaps he worked as a carpenter for all that time, perhaps he didn't. Whatever he'd been doing, learning must have been an important part of his life.

Learning from the Law and the Prophets and from the teachers, the Rabbis, of his faith. Learning about God the Father, no, more than that, learning to know God the Father and Mother, the one who loved him and, as he showed through his own life, loved everyone.

I don't know whether you will be travelling long distances in the next couple of months or whether you will be staying with the holiday makers around sunny (I hope) North Devon. Wherever we are I pray that, like Jesus, we will know God travelling with us, teaching us through the experiences we have and through the people we meet.

And I pray that alongside any travelling we may be doing we will find the space and time, as Jesus did, to simply be with God, enfolded in God's loving presence renewed, restored and revitalised.

May God be with us all wherever we are,




